

# GLOBAL CHANGE MAKER - LIBRARY FURBISHING PROJECT

**Duration** • A 5 Day/4 Night program in Siem Reap Cambodia.

- & Costs**
- Unlike many other charities, PeopleStories doesn't charge any registration fee and prefers to work with local businesses to make REAL impact.
  - US\$499 (\$99 per day) per person in a single occupied room plus a project materials cost of US\$95 (for wood, paint, seats, books etc) per person.
  - A discount of US\$50 per participant is applicable when 2 people sharing a room.
  - In-country costs only. Air tickets and optional travel experiences are excluded.

Arrival day! Orientation to cover the essentials for the coming days and jump start the program with a cultural training. In the evening, we share a royal Khmer set-dinner and finish the night with a walking tour at the local night market in Siem Reap - Pub Street.
